SYNOPSIS / PROBLEM:

This kit contains the parts needed to replace the touch panel on the model 8210 sweeper/scrubber.

Please follow step-by-step instructions.

SPECIAL TOOLS / CONSIDERATIONS: NONE

(Estimated time to complete: 1 hour)

PREPARATION:

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


FIG. 1 - Instrument Panel Assembly Breakdown

(Refer to FIG. 1)

FOR SAFETY: Before leaving or servicing machine, stop on level surface and set parking brake. Then turn off machine and remove key.

- 1. Open engine cover.
- 2. Disconnect battery cables from machine.

WARNING: Always disconnect battery cables from machine before working on electrical components.

- 3. Lower the steering wheel.
- 4. Locate the back side of the instrument panel assembly.

INSTALLATION:

(Refer to FIG. 1)

- 1. Remove and set aside all four 7mm mounting bracket nuts and both mounting brackets, so instrument panel assembly may be removed from the front. (Refer to FIG. 1)
- 2. Gently lift instrument panel assembly out far enough to access rear electrical connections.
- 3. Remove and set aside the 1/4 in securing screw from each electrical plug, on the back side of the touch panel assembly. Unplug connections.
- 4. Place instrument panel assembly on a clean work surface.
- 5. Remove and set aside the last four securing nuts on bottom of assembly. (Refer to FIG. 1)
- 6. Unwrap the first two folds of the wrist strap, and wrap the exposed adhesive side firmly around your wrist.

- 7. Unroll the rest of the band and peel the liner from the copper foil at the opposite end. Attach the copper foil to a convenient and exposed electrical ground.
- 8. Seperate touch panel from Instrument box, according to diagram. (Refer to FIG. 1)
- 9. Unplug the ribbon cable from the touch panel. (Refer to FIG. 1)
- 10. Plug the ribbon into the new touch panel. (Refer to FIG. 1)
- 11. Reassemble instrument panel assembly as shown in diagram. *Secure with hardware and blue locktite where indicated.* (Refer to FIG. 1)
- 12. Connect both electrical plugs and secure with 1/4 in securing screws.
- 13. Install instrument panel assembly back in dashboard. Align mounting brackets to hold the instrument panel in place, and tighten 7mm mounting bracket nuts.
- 14. Connect the battery cables.
- 15. Close the engine cover.
- 16. Start machine and check that the instrument panel operates properly.
