### **SYNOPSIS / PROBLEM:**

This kit contains the parts needed to replace the engine cover latch on the model 8200 sweeper/scrubbers with ID numbers lower than 6055 and 8210 sweeper scrubbers with ID numbers lower than 1061.

Please follow step-by-step instructions.

### **SPECIAL TOOLS / CONSIDERATIONS: Small file, small hand grinder, sand paper**

### **PREPARATION:**

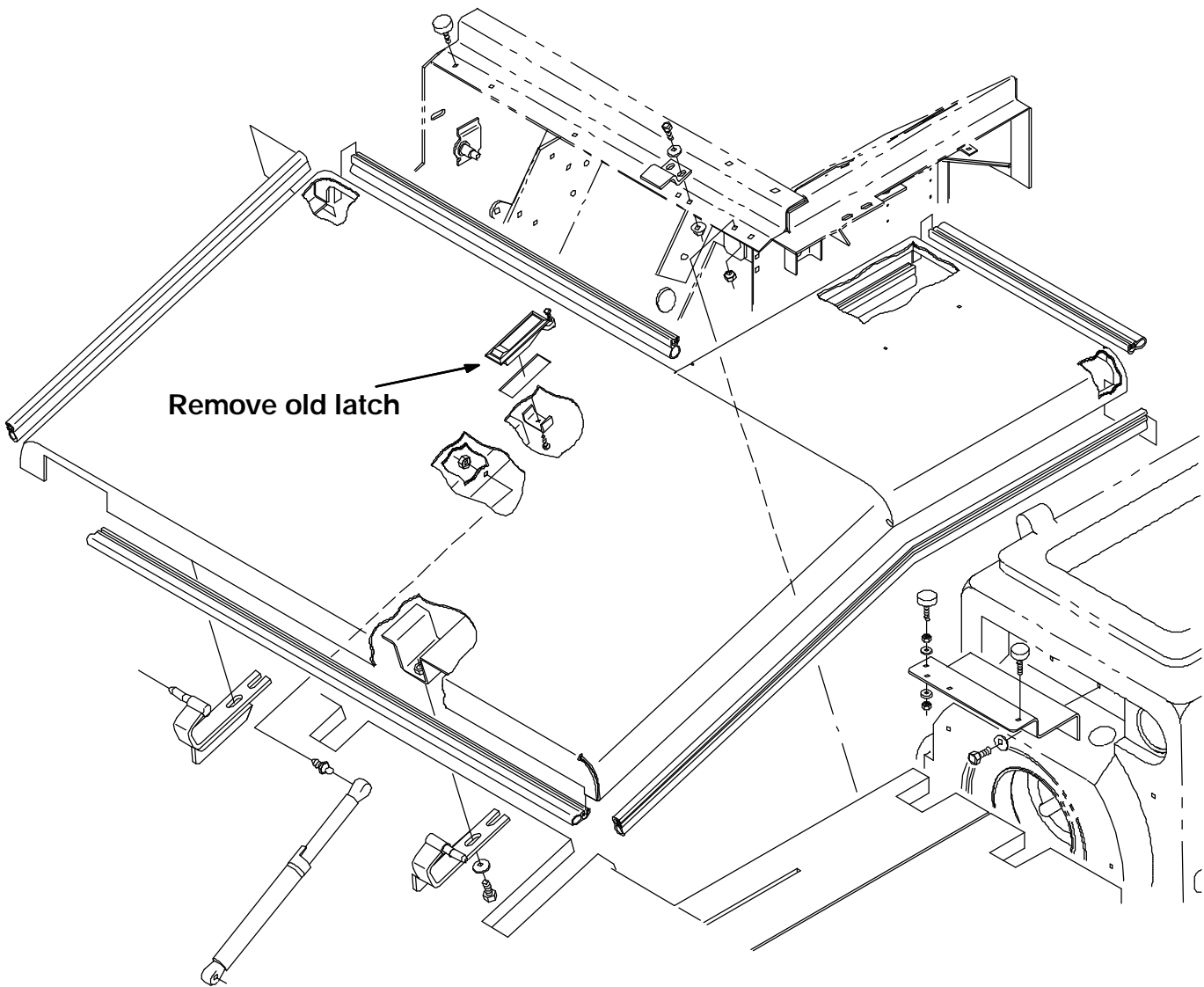

**FOR SAFETY: Before leaving or servicing machine, stop on level surface and set parking brake. Then turn off machine and remove key.**

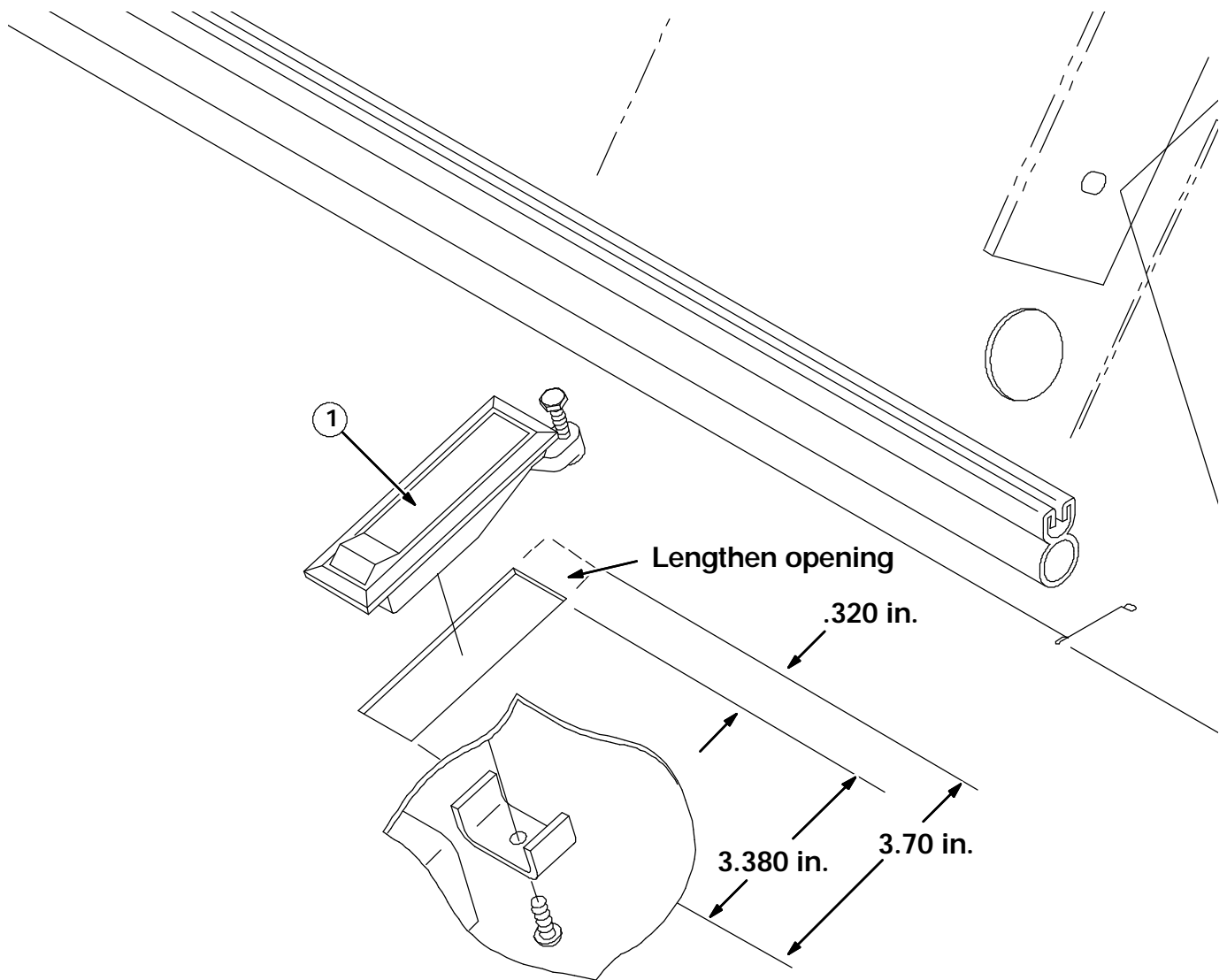
### **INSTALLATION:**

(Refer to FIG. 1 and 2)

1. Open engine cover.
2. Remove old engine cover latch.
3. Remove .320 inch of material from the top of the engine latch opening with a file or small hand detail grinder.
4. Sand the opened area smooth.
5. Install new engine cover latch (1).
