SUBJECT:

Amer brush motor (p/n 1000083) has been discontinued and replaced by an ASI brush motor (p/n 1048884). The new ASI brush motor, which is a direct replacement, has a higher efficiency (lower amp draw). Due to the lower amp draw, the circuit board software was also updated for the self-test procedure. The new circuit board part number is 1049275 – Software revision display date: 09-26-08.

**PURPOSE:** 

If you are replacing an Amer motor with an ASI motor you may experience a brush motor fault code when performing the self-test procedure due to the lower amp draw. To assure that the ASI brush motor is fine, verify that the motor reads more than 2.5 amps while operating. If the motor reads the specified amp draw, disregard fault (false open). The brush motor fault will only occur during the self-test procedure. If a brush motor fault code appears during normal operation, refer to the troubleshooting guide in your Service Manual.
