

## **Technical Service Bulletin**

MODEL(S) AFFECTED:	T7 AMR Autonomous Rider Scrubber equipped with Operating System 2.8 - 2.10
SUBJECT:	Safety concern - Potential pinch point hazard regarding the automated squeegee lift system when operating machine in manual mode.
PURPOSE:	Squeegee lift system behavior - When operator leaves the seat, the squeegee lift system is triggered to automatically raise off the floor. However, the activation has a 25 second delay before the squeegee lift system is raised. There is a risk of a potential pinch hazard if the operator interacts with the squeegee system during this time span. <b>FOR SAFETY:</b> To prevent a potential pinch point hazard, it is advised to wait until the squeegee lift system is in the raised position before interacting with squeegee system.
NOTES:	Subsequent OS software releases will remove the automated squeegee system lift in both autonomous

Squeegee Lift System - When operator leaves the seat during manual mode there is a 25 second delay before squeegee begins to lift.
